DO YOU KNOW?

1. In 1993, Spring-Ford had 3 backs (Joe Haley, Malcolm McLeod, and James Barnett) who rushed for 100+ yards in a game vs. St. Pius X
2. In 2010 Spring-Ford defeated Sussex Tech, who returned the leading rusher in the state of Delaware, Desmond Sivels, and Owen J. Roberts, who returned the leading rusher in the state of Pennsylvania, Ryan Brumfield, in successive weeks.
3. In the first ever "White Out" at McNelly Stadium, Spring-Ford defeated Owen J. Roberts 20-7 in front of an estimated 5,000+ fans.
4. The Spring-Ford Touchdown Club was officially started in 2011.
5. Spring-Ford scored 13 seconds into the 2011 season when Jarred Jones returned the opening kickoff for a 90-yard touchdown, the first time he ever touched the football in varsity action.
6. Spring-Ford defeated Pottsgrove 49-35 in 2011, which ended a 12-year losing streak versus the Falcons.
7. The 42-0 shutout Spring-Ford recorded versus Owen J. Roberts in 2011 was the only shutout in the whole 2011 PAC-10 season.
8. Three different quarterbacks, Hank Coyne, J.J. Paige, and Ryan Conway, each threw touchdown passes versus Boyertown in 2011.
9. Spring-Ford lost at home to Coatesville 60-28 in its first appearance in the PIAA AAAA District I playoffs in 2011.
10. Spring-Ford sophomore, Brian Clarke, tragically died when the bicycle he was riding was hit by a car. The Brian Clarke Special Teams Award is now given to the best special teams performer by the Spring-Ford Touchdown Club.
11. Andrew Scanlan became the first Spring-Ford football player to be named to the prestigious Big 33 game in 2012.
12. Spring-Ford opened the 2012 season by scoring 18 points in the 4th quarter to come back to beat District 11 power Whitehall 30-21.
13. The 2012 Rams beat Garnet Valley, Ridley, and Pennridge in consecutive weeks to appear in the PIAA AAAA District I Finals, becoming the District I runner-up to the Eastern Final Champion, Coatesville.
14. Zameer McDowell became the first Spring-Ford football player to be named to the PSFCA East / West All-Star game in 2013.
15. Tate Carter had one of the best all-around offensive seasons in Spring-Ford history in 2012 when he caught 43 passes for 586 yards and 5 TDs, ran for 714 yards and 7.1 yards per carry and 10 TDs, threw a TD pass, and returned a kickoff for a TD.
16. Spring-Ford was 25-3 (21-0 in the regular season) in games in which Jarred Jones started at RB in 2011-13.
17. 2013 marked the third straight year in which Spring-Ford won at least 10 games and qualified for District I AAAA playoffs.
18. Robby Varner and Mason Romano were both named to the PSFCA East-West game in 2014, becoming the first Spring-Ford teammates to play in the game.
19. The 2014 graduating class ended their 3-year careers with more wins than any other class in Spring-Ford history, accumulating 32 wins.
20. Spring-Ford opened the 2015 season by scoring 21 4th quarter points to come from behind to defeat the preseason Pennsylvania AAAA #7-ranked State College Little Lions 28-25 in Royersford. Ricky Venuto threw 4 TD passes in his first varsity start.

22. In 2015, due to the Warriors new turf field not being ready, Spring-Ford hosted Methacton and wore all-white visitor's uniforms at McNelly Stadium. They won the game 82-0.
23. Owen Gulati's 43-yard field goal vs. Owen J. Roberts in 2015 broke his brother, David's, record of 42.
24. In a tight game where both teams were 9-0 and playing for the league championship, the Spring-Ford football team was put in a bind at halftime in a 7-6 game when the band's senior night took longer than the allotted time and the officials assigned an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty on S-F to start the second half. On the 1st play of the 3rd quarter, Stone Scarcelle ran 80 yards for a touchdown and Spring-Ford never looked back, beating PV 28-14 and completing an undefeated regular season in front of an estimated 8,000 fans at McNelly Stadium.
25. The 2015 season marked the 3rd straight year that a Spring-Ford player was named the Defensive Player of the Year in the PAC when Steve Rice was honored. Steve followed Brendan Zimmie and Mason Romano from the previous two years.
26. Trey Jarmon became the 5th Spring-Ford player to be named to the PSFCA East-West game in 2016. This was the 4th consecutive year that the Spring-Ford program placed a player in that game and the 5th consecutive year that a Spring-Ford player was named to a state level all-star game.
27. In 2012, when all four of Spring-Ford's defensive lineman (RJ Sheldon, Zameer McDowell, Mason Romano, and Robby Varner) were named 1st Team All-PAC, through 2015, the Ram's defensive lineman claimed 10 of a possible 16 1st Team All-PAC defensive line honors. The other players were Alec Vagnozzi, Brendan Zimmie, Danny Kelchner, and Tim Rudderow, with Romano and Varner being honored in both their junior and senior seasons.
28. The 9-3 2016 team lost to Wilson, District 3 Champion and state semi-finalist, in overtime 41-40, Perkiomen Valley, a District 1 semi-finalist, 28-16, and to North Penn, District 1 Champion and state semi-finalist, 28-19. The 3 losses were by a combined 22 points.
29. The 2016 team was only the 2nd in Spring-Ford history to score 500 or more points. The only other team to do that was the 2012 team (that played 3 more games).
30. Matt Gibson and Selwyn Simpson unselfishly shared the running back duties from 2014-16. Combined they would have finished 3rd in Spring-Ford history in career carries (596), 3rd in career rushing yards (4,265), and 1st in scoring (408). Additionally, their combined 63 receptions would have put them 3rd on the career receptions list.

Awards Criteria
